**It's Carnival year at the White Rock South Surrey Skating Club!** Once again our club will be presenting an ice show, featuring each and every skater in the club. Following the success of our 2007 production which was staged at South Surrey Arena for the very first time, be prepared for spectacular skating routines, creative and dazzling costumes - and featuring professional lighting and sound. This is an event not to be missed!

Please note the following details:

1. **PARTICIPATION:** Carnival is a club event; all of our skaters will be participating, from the tiniest Tot to the most senior competitive skater.
2. **COST:** The mandatory Carnival fee for most skaters is \$50, which includes the costume fee and helps with many of the additional costs associated with Carnival. Because STARSkate/Competitive skaters participate in two numbers, their fee is \$95.
3. **COSTUMES:** Costumes will either be purchased or designed. Parents will receive the material and pattern necessary to complete the costume shortly before Christmas. Each Carnival group will have a Costume Convener who will make the prototype, distribute the material and act as a resource person. If your costume is purchased, some alterations may need to be made. The cost of making or altering your costume is the responsibility of each skater.
4. **PRACTICE TIMES:** Carnival practices will begin in early February. Please be aware that lesson time for CanSkate, CanSkate Tots and Accelerated STARSkate programs ends when Carnival practices begin, and that some STARSkate/Competitive sessions will also be changed to accommodate Carnival practices. There will be no group lessons during Carnival practice time, and your Carnival practice time may not necessarily be at the same time as your regular skating time. All program pricing for the season has been adjusted accordingly.
5. **REHEARSALS:** There will be final rehearsals on March 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> at South Surrey Arena; details and times to be announced.
6. **PHOTOGRAPHS:** Individual and group photos are taken of skaters in their costumes. These photos are used for the program and are also available for purchase. Photo Day is scheduled for Saturday February 14<sup>th</sup> at South Surrey Arena; times to be announced.
7. **VOLUNTEERS:** CARNIVAL IS RUN BY VOLUNTEERS! We need many, many volunteers to make the show a success; any assistance you can offer will be appreciated. Please complete the volunteer section of the Carnival registration form which was included with your skating registration package.
8. **INFORMATION UPDATES:** Updates will be posted on the bulletin board in the Centennial Arena lobby, on the club website and will also be distributed by email. Please check regularly.
